

Assistant Professor Strategic Media & Public Relations

The Walter Cronkite School of Journalism and Mass Communication at Arizona State University seeks to hire a tenure-track Assistant Professor for its Strategic Media & Public Relations specialization to begin Fall 2008.

The duties of the position include engaging in scholarly research, teaching undergraduate and master's students, and providing service to the academy and the profession. The required qualifications for the position are a Ph.D. and at least five years of professional experience in strategic media and/or public relations. The desired qualification for the position is fluency in English and Spanish.

Accredited by the Accrediting Council on Education in Journalism and Mass Communication, the Cronkite School offers instruction in strategic media and public relations and print, broadcast and online journalism. The school provides superior support for active research including annual dean's grants and generous travel allowances. Arizona State University is the nation's largest Research I institution and is located in the Phoenix metropolitan area.

In August 2008 the Cronkite School will move into a state-of-the-art facility in Downtown Phoenix. The six-story, 223,000-square-foot complex will be located on the northern end of ASU's Downtown Phoenix campus and will be fully equipped with cutting-edge amenities and will include newsrooms, computer labs, TV studios, classrooms, offices and an auditorium.
